OPEN DOORS TO MINISTRY

“Furthermore, when I came to Troas to preach Christ’s gospel, and a door was opened unto me of the Lord” (2Cor. 2:12).

I have just returned from Canada where the Lord has opened another door of opportunity for our ministry. It was my joy and privilege to minister with Pastor Jaroslav Bossak, pastor of Ukrainian Pentecostal Temple in Edmonton, Alberta Canada. The seminar on Evangelism and soul winning was well attended with excellent response. The various other services were blessed with seekers receiving answers to their prayers.

In July 2006 Donna and I ministered in the annual Family Camp Meeting at the Moose Lake Camp in Alberta Canada for the Canadian Assemblies of God of the western Slavic region under the direction of Bishop Michael Brandebura. Over the past ten years I have ministered on several occasions in Ukraine with Pastor Brandebura and not until last year was it possible for our schedules to coincide for us to minister in the camp meeting.

A GLORIOUS MIRACLE AWAITED US

Shortly before going to Canada for the camp meeting we received word that Brother Brandebura was critically ill and in the hospital. When we arrived the report from the doctors was that he would not be able to live more than a day or two. In fact, the doctor said if it were his father he would remove the life supports and let him go.

You can imagine the cloud of heaviness that settled on the people at the camp after hearing this report. BUT GOD—intervened, giving me a prophetic word for the people—“he shall live and not die”, and following a session of intense corporate prayer “in the Spirit” by the congregation the atmosphere changed dramatically.

Soon after the camp meeting Brother Brandebura was dismissed from the hospital, a healed man, much to the amazement of the doctors. He and his lovely wife, Ann, spent the winter as they normally do in Florida. They returned to Canada in early April. What a joy it was to see him waiting for me at the airport, normal as ever. To see him walk, lift suitcases, drive the car, etc., you would never know that ten months ago he was given up to die. In addition, Pastor Jaroslav and I took him to the airport on Saturday to catch a flight to Vancouver to minister several days and install a new pastor in one of the churches. The

Lord Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever and still works miracles. WE GIVE GOD ALL THE GLORY!

OPEN DOOR TO NEPAL UPDATE

In our last newsletter I reported about the young men from Nepal who graduated from our Malabar College of Theology in Kerala, South India. The door to Nepal has opened to us and we have already placed these three graduates there who have begun evangelizing, church planting, and establishing an MTC extension school of training for ministry. By the end of June we will have four additional young men that have been trained at our

Following the graduation of the 19th School of Ministry in Crimea, I conducted evangelistic services in a public school, churches, and a large theater building. In all of these services we witnessed the hand of God move upon the people saving, healing and delivering people oppressed by the devil.

The schedule of meetings and travel was very tight with little time to rest. Following these
